ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVE TO VILNIUS / LITHUANIA

Arrival at Vilnius International Airport (Lithuania), located 15 minutes from downtown. Pick up from Vilnius airport by an English speaking member of the tour operator "Discover Baltics". Private bus transfer to hotel. **Welcome dinner.** Accommodation in Vilnius.

DAY 2: VILNIUS

Breakfast. Tour with the English speaking guide to the **historical Vilnius center**, listed in **World Heritage sites by UNESCO in 1994**. Visit buildings, monuments and most representative places such as: **Gediminas castle, Vilnius Cathedral, Presidential Palace, St. Peter and St. Paul church, St. Ana's church, Vilnius University, old town, Jewish quarter and gates of Dawn**. Lunch. Free time in the afternoon to shopping, do some activity leisure or visit some of the many museums of the capital such as the National Museum, the Museum of Contemporary Art, the Museum of Victims of Genocide, etc. Dinner. Overnight in Vilnius.

Optional: After lunch visit the užupis quarter (called "užupio respublika"), known as the small montmartre of Vilnius.

DAY 3: KERNAVĖ / TRAKAI

Breakfast. Departure by coach to visit the first known capital of Lithuania, **Kernavė** a small village located 35 km northwest of Vilnius. It may visit **Kernavė archaeological site** included in the list of **World Heritage sites Humanity by Unesco since 2004**, which consists of a set of archaeological, historical and cultural, including their own Kernavė town, a series of fortifications, **several settlements no fortified, burial sites and other archaeological monuments** which will dating to the Middle Paleolithic Ages. Following the trip to the other ancient capital of Lithuania, **Trakai**. The people Trakai is located only 30 km Western Vilnius, on Lake Galve, **within of Trakai Historical National Park**. Lunch. Visit



the town and its famous **Trakai Castle** situated on an island Lake Galve. Return to Vilnius. Dinner. Overnight in Vilnius.

DAY 4: HILL OF CROSSES / RUNDĀLE

Breakfast. Departure by bus towards Riga. Stop at the **Hill of Crosses** near the city of Siauliai (Lithuania), place become a **center of pilgrimage Lithuanian** and in which there are **thousands of crosses constructed from the XIX century**, different sizes, materials and shapes as a symbol of people's resistance Lithuanian against the Russian occupation. Is a unique place in the world. Lunch. Following the trip to Riga. Stop in the town of **Rundāle** (Latvia) to visit the **Palace of Rundāle**, built in 1780 by the architect Italian Bartolomeo Rastrelli, the same as Peterhof Palace built on the outskirts St. Petersburg (Russia). The palace, **old residence of the Dukes of Kurland is a real gem Baroque Latvian erected in the countryside**. Following the trip to **Riga**. Arrival the capital of Latvia. Dinner. Accommodation Riga.

DAY 5: RIGA

Breakfast. Guided tour of the **historic center Riga**, included in the list of sites **Heritage Site by the Unesco since 1997**, within which can be viewed and / or visit the **Lutheran Cathedral Santa Maria, the Lutheran Church of San Peter, the House of the Blackheads, the Catholic Cathedral of Santiago, the Freedom Monument, Castle Riga and the Art Nouveau district, one of the best examples of his style of all Europe, among others**. Lunch. Leisure after lunch for shopping, enjoy the many attractions and charm that has the city of Riga or visit one of the many museums found scattered around the city such as the Museum of the Occupation, the Museum of History and Navigation, etc. Dinner. Accommodation in Riga.

Optional: after lunch boat trip trough the river Daugava.



DAY 6: TALLIN

Breakfast. Departure by bus to Tallinn located approximately 300 km north Riga. Arrival to the capital of Estonia. Lunch. Guided tour of the **historic center Tallinn**, included in the list of sites **Heritage Site by the Unesco in 1997**, within which may be view and / or visiting among other places **Square City Hall, the Orthodox Cathedral of Aleksander Nevski, the Lutheran Cathedral the Blessed Virgin Mary, the old city walls, the Museum of Occupation and Kadriorg Palace**, the former summer residence of Tsar Peter the Great in the s. XVIII and located outside Tallinn. Dinner. Accommodation in Tallinn.

DAY 7: NACIONAL PARK OF LAHEMAA

Breakfast. Departure by bus to the **Park Lahemaa National**. This park, **the most large Estonia** and situated 40 km west of Tallinn, **is composed of dense forests, numerous lakes, rivers and waterfalls**. Furthermore, within the same may provide numerous **estates XVIII century**, the ancient heritage German landowners who administered these lands until the early twentieth century. Lunch. Return to Tallinn. **Free afternoon** in Tallinn to shop, visit any of the many museums the city offers or any other leisure activity and entertainment. **Farewell dinner**. Accommodation in Tallinn.

DAY 8: DEPARTURE

Breakfast. Departure by bus to the Tallinn International Airport. **End our services.**
