### ITINERARY<sup>1</sup>

#### DAY 1: ARRIVE TOVILNIUS/ LITHUANIA

**Arrival at Vilnius International Airport** (Lithuania), located 15 minutes from downtown. Pick up from Vilnius airport by an English speaking member of the tour operator "Discover Baltics". Private bus transfer to hotel. **Welcome dinner.** Accommodation in Vilnius.

#### DAY 2: VILNIUS / TRAKAI

Breakfast. Tour with the English speaking guide to the **historical Vilnius center**, listed in **World Heritage sites by UNESCO in 1994**. Visit buildings, monuments and most representative places such as: **Gediminas castle, Vilnius Cathedral, Presidential Palace, St. Peter and St. Paul church, St. Ana's church, Vilnius University, old town, Jewish quarter and gates of Dawn.** Lunch. Trip by bus to **Trakai**, to the **medieval capital of Lithuania**, situated 28 km west of Vilnius on the banks of lake Galvė. **Visit the famous Trakai castle located on an island of lake Galvė.** Return to Vilnius. Dinner. Accommodation in Vilnius.

#### DAY 3: KAUNAS / KLAIPĒDA

Breakfast. Departure by bus to Klaipėda, which is the only country's port city and third largest city of Lithuania, situated just over 300 km west of the capital, along the Baltic Sea. Stop in the second largest city of Lithuania, **Kaunas**. **Visit to Kaunas Cathedral, town hall square ("Rotušės aikštė"), avenue of freedom ("Laisvės alėja"), famous house of the Pagan god Perkūnas and several gothic churches.** Lunch. The trip to **Klaipėda**. **Visit to old town, in which you will see some examples of German style building and its famous Theater square.** Dinner. Accommodation in Klaipėda.

*Optional: visit to the Etnografic Museum in Rumsiškiės, close of Kaunas, after lunch.*

#### DAY 4: PENINSULA OF CURONIA

Breakfast. **Departure** by bus to visit the **Curonian Spit**. Transfer by ferry from Klaipėda to the Curonian Spit. The Curonian

**Spit included in the list of World Heritage sites of UNESCO since 2000**, is a narrow strip that separates the Curonian Lagoon from the Baltic Sea, composed of sandy and huge dunes. **Stop in the small town Juodkrantė to see the hill of witches ("Raganų kalnas").** The trip to **Nida**. **Visit to Parnidis dune ("Parnidžio kopa") and walk through the village.** Lunch. Return to Klaipėda. Dinner. Accommodation in Klaipėda.

#### DAY 5: PALANGA / HILL OF CROSSES / RUNDĀLE

Breakfast. Departure by bus to Riga. Short stop in **Palanga, where is the main destination of summer.** Walk around the city to the sea. Following the trip to Riga. Stop in **Hill of Crosses**, near the city Šiauliai (Lithuania), instead become pilgrimage center in the Lithuanian and which there are thousands of crosses built since the XIX century, different sizes, materials and shapes as a symbol of Lithuanian people's resistance against Russian occupation. Is a unique place in the world. Continued trip to Riga. Stop in **Rundāle (Latvia)** to visit the **Palace of Rundāle**, built in 1780 by the Italian architect Bartolomeo Rastrelli, the same as built Peterhof Palace, the palace, **once residence of the Dukes Courland, is a jewel of Baroque Latvian erected in the countryside.** Arrival in Riga. Dinner. Accommodation in Riga.

#### DAY 6: RIGA

Breakfast. Guided tour of the **historic center Riga, a World Heritage Site by Unesco since 1997**, within which can visit the **Lutheran Cathedral of St. Mary, the Lutheran Church of San Pedro, the House of the Blackheads, the cathedral Catholic James, the Monument to the Freedom, Riga Castle and the District of Art Nouveau** and others. Lunch. Time free after lunch to make shopping or enjoy the many attractions offered by the city of Riga. Dinner. Accommodation in Riga.

*Optional: After lunch visit to the Spa city of Jūrmala, aprox. 30 km from Riga.*

#### DAY 7: NACIONAL PARK OF GAUJA

Breakfast. Departure by bus to Tallinn located just under 300 km from Riga. Stop to visit the **National Park Gauja** (Latvia), established in 1973 and near the capital of Latvia, in the **valley Gauja River**. Visit the park within the which are visited several medieval castles belonging to the Order of Livonia. Lunch. Following the trip to Tallinn. Arrival to the capital of Estonia. **Time free to explore the city of Tallinn.** Dinner. Accommodation in Tallinn.

#### DAY 8: TALLIN

Breakfast. Guided tour of the **historic center Tallinn, Heritage of Humanity Unesco since 1997**, within which among other places you can visit the **Plaza City Hall, the Orthodox Cathedral of Aleksander Nevski, the Lutheran Cathedral the Blessed Virgin Mary and the old walls of the city and elsewhere.** Lunch. Free time to visit some of the capital's museums, shopping, do any other leisure activity. Dinner Accommodation in Tallinn.

*Optional: After lunch visit to the Palace Kadriorg, located on the outskirts of Tallin.*

#### DAY 9: NATIONAL PARK OF LAHEMAA

Breakfast. Departure by bus to the **Park Lahemaa National**. This park, the **most large Estonia** and situated 40 km west of Tallinn, **is composed of dense forests, numerous lakes, rivers and waterfalls.** Furthermore, within the same may provide numerous **estates XVIII century**, the ancient heritage German landowners who administered these lands until the early twentieth century. Lunch. Return to Tallinn. **Free afternoon** in Tallinn to shop, visit any of the many museums the city offers or any other leisure activity and entertainment. **Farewell dinner**. Accommodation in Tallinn.

#### DAY 10: DEPARTURE

Breakfast. Departure by bus to the Tallinn International Airport. **End our services.**
